On the basis of § 18 par. 1 no. 3 of the basic regulations of the Beuth University of Applied Sciences Berlin of 26 March 2007 (AM 20/2011, BeuthHS-GrO) in conjunction with § 18 par. 4, BeuthHS-GrO, the Commission for fee statutes concerning the Distance Learning Institute (established by decision 5/12 Board of Trustees) in conjunction with § 2, par. 2, of the rules for the levying of fees and charges (GebEntgeltO) in the version of 1 June 2004 (AM 50/2004), on 30 May 2008 (AM 43/08) and § 2 par. 8 of the Berlin Act on HEIs (BerIHG) as amended by the new notification on 26 July 2011 (GVBl. p. 378) decided on the subsequent 2nd amendment of the regulation of 16 June 2011 (AM 30/2011) for the educational and postgraduate Master's degree programme "MBA Renewables", last modified on 24 September 2012 (AM 90/2012). The Board of Trustees took note of this decision on 6 June 2014:

§ 1 Amendment

1. Item 2 is replaced by the following passage:

"2. In accordance with par. 1, for participation in the degree programme €2,800 is charged every semester (for each of the first four scheduled semesters as well as for the 5th scheduled semester of the Master's final examination period the expense amounts to €14,000)." The total amount of fees is also due when the total number of credits of the degree program has been earned before the standard period of time required to complete the degree program has expired. Participation in the first semester of the course requires at least 40 new registrations."

2. Item 3 is replaced by the following passage:

"3. If modules are attended as a form of further education, the fee amounts to €1,100 per module."

§ 2 Commencement of New Regulations and Transitional Arrangements

- (1) These regulations come into force on the day after publication in the official notifications of the Beuth University of Applied Sciences Berlin and apply starting with the fall semester 2014/2015.
- (2) The regulations of the setting of module fees from 16 June 2011 (AM 30/11) and the 1st amendment from 24 September 2012 (AM 90/12) still apply to those students already enrolled.
