Based on § 23 para. 1 no. 3 of the bylaws of the Beuth University of Applied Sciences Berlin of March 26, 2007 (Official Notifications 20/2011, BeuthHS-GrO) in conjunction with §§ 7 a, 71 of the Berlin Higher Education Act (BerlHG), as amended in the revised notification of July 26, 2011 (GVBl. / Legal and Regulatory Gazette p. 378), last modified by the law amending the Berlin Higher Education Act of June 30, 2017 (GVBl./ Legal and Regulatory Gazette, p. 338), the Faculty Council of Department I of the Beuth University of Applied Sciences in Berlin on May 18, 2017 decided on the subsequent “Regulations for Admission for the Further-Education Master Distance Learning Degree Programme MBA Renewables (MBA/RE/FSI)“; in accordance with §13 para.1 no. 5 of BeuthHS-GrO in conjunction with §§ 7 a, 61 of the Berlin Higher Education Act (BerlHG), the Academic Senate gave a statement of approval on June 22, 2017. On June 23, 2017 the university administration confirmed these regulations in accordance with § 90 para. 1 of the Berlin Higher Education Act (BerlHG).

Regulations for Admission

§ 1 Validity of the Regulations Governing the Rules for Admission and Enrolment at the Beuth University of Applied Sciences Berlin, subsequently referred to as OZI.

The provisions for the OZI in their respectively valid version are an integral component of these regulations.

§ 2 Requirements for Admission

- (1) In terms of § 23 para. 3 no. 2 of the law governing the universities of the federal state of Berlin (BerlHG, Berlin Higher Education Act) the distance learning Master's degree programme *MBA Renewables* is treated like a further-education Master's degree programme. This concerns a degree programme with focus on civil engineering and business administration.
- (2) Participation in the degree programme *MBA Renewables* requires as a prerequisite a higher-education degree qualifying the graduate for entry into a profession together with additional subsequent qualified practical experience in the profession generally amounting to no less than two years.
- (3) Adequate English skills are required for participation in the degree programme enabling students to acquire study contents in English. When requested, proof of a student's ability to study in English and documentation of one's language skills is to be provided at latest by the deadline for enrolment. The required skills correspond to the level B2 based on the *Common European Framework of Reference for Languages* (GER). English language skills are deemed to be sufficiently provided in connection with a higher education entrance qualification from a school with English as the instruction language or a university degree obtained in English.

Language level B2 (GER) can be ascertained as follows:

- a) Indication of language level B2 on the school-leaving certificate (higher education entrance qualification)
- b) IELTS 5,0
- c) One of the following Cambridge Examinations:
First Certificate (FCE), Advanced (CAE), Proficiency (CPE)
- d) TOEFL: iBT 80
- e) UNIcert® II

Verification other than specified under a) to e) can be recognized on a case-by-case basis. The decision is made by the degree programme directors.



§ 3 Coming into Effect

These regulations come into effect on the day following their publication in the Official Notifications of the Beuth University of Applied Sciences Berlin for the winter term 2017/18.
